Free & Reduced Meal (FRM) Application

ENRICHMENT VS. SPORTS

ENRICHMENT: All leaders must obtain enrichment hours for promotional requirements. By the end of a leader's freshmen year, they should have 0.25 hours. On the other hand, by the end of their sophomore year they must obtain 0.50 hours. **This trimester we are offering: Performance Chorus and Weight Lifting. In order to participate in an enrichment, leaders must pay an initial \$10 fee (cash) before the course begins and an additional \$25 by the end of the trimester.** Please check with your leader to see if they are signed up to take an enrichment.

SPORTS: Leaders do not have to participate in sports each trimester. **However, if they choose to play a sport, it is always \$50 for each sport up to the third sport. If a leader plays more than 2 sports in a year, they will never be charged more than \$100.** All fees must be paid by the end of each sports season to ensure your leader is able to play other sports throughout the year. We are currently offering: cheerleading, soccer, football, and volleyball. Please be mindful if your leader is currently playing, a sport fees must be paid by Tuesday, September 9, 2014.

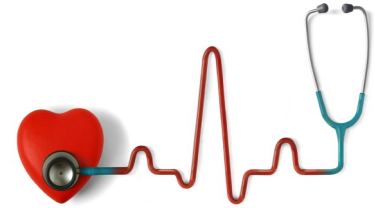

What You Need to Know About LaSalle

- Leaders may receive a LaSalle for incomplete or missing homework.
- Monday LaSalle: 3:45-5:55. Tuesday – Thursday LaSalle: 3:45-4:55
- Although Leaders are given an opportunity to either complete or correct his/her homework, the ultimate consequence is a 0 for the assignment if it is not turned in.
- Leaders may only receive up to 50% credit for a homework assignment that he or she has to complete in LaSalle.
- Leaders who do not attend LaSalle will receive 4 demerits. 4 demerits = Detention. A Leader can also receive 4 demerits for not attending LaSalle if a parent/guardian asks for a dismissal before LaSalle is over.
- Leaders who receive multiple LaSalles in one day will receive demerits. The first LaSalle is free. Each additional LaSalle = 1 demerit. For example, 3 LaSalles = 2 demerits.
- If a leader is more than 3 minutes late, he/she will not be allowed to enter and earn 4 demerits.

Safe Passage Route

- Off-duty CPD officers are posted along the route for the safety of our Leaders
- Not taking the route = 1 day suspension
- Route should be taken during arrival and dismissal
- Taking the Safe Passage Route is a non-negotiable because the safety of our Leaders is a non-negotiable

Discipline Trends

Our Leaders are the BEST! We don't call them Leaders for nothing. However, there are six areas that can be improved to ensure that our Leaders are always Number 1!

1. **Talking** – I'm sure parents/guardians know this better than the staff. Let's remind our Leaders that talking means you aren't listening. Listening is imperative as it means you are acquiring the information necessary to be successful.
2. **Not acting SMART and 3. Off-task** – Leaders must sit up straight and pay attention at all times. Learning is happening and our teachers do not want you to miss anything.
4. **Tardy <1 Minute** – Some of our Leaders are struggling with time management and organization. Ask them what is his or her area of improvement and give them strategies so that they make it to class on time. A good life lesson is being punctual could be the difference between you getting the job or not.
5. **Dress Code** – The good thing is Leaders are correcting their infractions! This means they understand the dress code and are following it.
6. **Multiple LaSalles** – Leaders receive homework every night, from every class. Leaders are reminded to write down the homework assignment in his/her agenda. Check their agendas so that you are aware of what they need to complete and when it's due.
