Principal's Message

Butler College Prep and the A. Phillip Randolph Museum



It is an interesting coincidence that Butler College Prep is situated directly across the street from the A. Phillip Randolph Pullman Porter Museum. Both institutions share a focus on the Arts and Social Justice. The museum is named after men who made history - Asa Philip Randolph and Pullman Porters, the men who made up the membership of the Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters (BSCP) union.

Randolph was the chief organizer and co-founder of the BSCP, the first African-American labor union in the country to win a collective bargaining agreement. Under Randolph's leadership, the Pullman Porters fought a valiant battle for employment equality with the corporate giant, the Pullman Rail Car Company. Their pioneering efforts created the first bona fide union for the African American worker. This victorious struggle in America's early labor movement was also the doorway through which many civil rights gains were made.

Butler College Prep and the A. Phillip Randolph Museum have launched a new partnership. In an effort to commemorate the partnership, the Museum hosted a Kick Off Press Conference on Friday, September 12th. Several of Butler's Leaders attended you would have been extremely proud at how they represented themselves and the school. Lynx improve with a win over Harper 24-8

After their lost in the season opener last week, the Lynx Football Team who was shorthanded bounded back yesterday with a convincing win over the Cardinals of Harper High School. The offense lead by Quarterback, Keondre Rollins, showed improvement scoring 24 points. Rollins accounted for 2 of the 3 touchdowns as he ran and threw for another. Rollins scored on a 30 yard quarterback keeper and threw a 50 yard touchdown pass to Donnell Williams for his only completion of the game. Kaelen Ward added to the scoreboard as he took a reverse 90 yards for a touchdown on 4th and 15. The Defense was just as good, led by defensive tackle ▲ Preston Powell, who made his debut with 3 sacks and 2 tackles for loss. Dion Gilbert pitched in with an interception and returned it 20 yards before getting smash on the sideline. The defense did not allow any points and made 2 great defensive stand inside the 5 yard line. The offensive gave up a touchdown on a fumble that was return for a 30 yard touchdown.
