Discipline News

Leaders, if you know your transportation will not be able to pick you up from 3:45pm -4:00pm, then you should attend office hours. Leaders should inform your parents if they are staying for Office Hours in Advisory. If you are outside after 4:00, then you will be issued 2 demerits for loitering. Office hours ends at 4:45pm; therefore, you must be picked up and/or off school grounds by 5:00. If you are in LaSalle, then you have 15 minutes from the dismissal time to be off school grounds or in practice or Enrichment. If not, then you will be issued 2 demerits for loitering. If you are attending an enrichment or sports practice, then you have 15 minutes after the scheduled dismissal to be off school grounds. If you are not, then you will be issued 2 demerits for loitering. Please have a means of effective and timely transportation daily.

During Friday Detention, Leaders are given a packet to complete. This packet is used as a means for Leaders to reflect on his or her behavior and to further develop problem solving skills so that he or she does not come to detention again. Leaders who do not complete the packet in the allotted time during detention will receive a Monday LaSalle. LaSalle is 2 hours on Monday.
