## SES— Supplemental Educational Services

Butler College Prep is offering a great opportunity for **ALL Leaders** to receive **FREE** tutorial services provided by SES. Please review the SES booklet and complete the attached form for one of the following educational providers:

**Educate Online pg. 28**

Educate Online serves leaders in grades K– 12 in reading and math. Leaders login to a secure website while a teacher logs on from another location. They provide computers and internet access to families who need computers to participate in the program. Families incur no cost with the Educate Online program.

**Tutoria Con iPads pg. 69**

Tutoria Con iPads provide individualized, one-on-one tutoring in a safe online environment, with tutors who all have at least a Bachelor's degree. Before the start of the tutoring program, the Leaders take an assessment test. On the basis of the results of the test, Individual Learning Plans are formulated to help tutors assist educational goals. To enable a Leader to participate, a Internet-enabled iPad will be provided to the students as needed. Tutoring is available in grades K—12 in the areas of math, reading, and science.

**Education Masters pg. 30**

Education Masters challenges and engages all Leaders in grades 6th—12th by addressing the wide variety of abilities and learning styles with its interactive and adaptive curriculum in mathematics and reading. Through the use of unique assessment techniques, the Basic Achievement Skills Inventory, individuals needs of assistance are identified to tailor an Individual Learning Plan and curriculum to target instruction. The Leaders choose when and where to do the tutoring program to meet their needs; Leaders must maintain a cumulative 2 hour average of tutoring per week or they may be dropped at Education Masters discretion.
