### Discipline

Detention will be held this Friday from 1-3. If your leader has a 3 hour detention, then their detention will be from 1-4.

Leaders will no longer be allowed to wait outside or in the lobby after dismissal at 3:45 Monday - Thursday and 1:00 on Friday (3:00 if your leader has detention). All leaders will be pushed away from the building and off the premises. Due to pending inclement weather, the culture of the school and most importantly, the safety of all leaders, it is imperative that leaders are either in office hours or heading home right after dismissal.

Leaders waiting on rides that do not come shortly after dismissal will be pushed into office hours and those using public transportation will be immediately ushered away from the building.
