Q2 Interim Testing

At the end of every quarter, we as a Noble Network, assess our leaders on their knowledge of the College Readiness Standards. We take these formal assessments very seriously as this has become our number one re-teaching toll across the network. This week the leaders took the Open Ended Response Assessment (OER). The OER included a writing section in the following areas: English/Reading, Science, and Math. Are you failing any of your promotional requirements??

Our goal is for all leaders to receive a quality education in a safe environment which will result in leaders graduating high school and attending college. For this reason, we offer several supports for leaders to be the best in all promotional requirement areas (i.e. attendance, health/fitness, academics, enrichment, community service and discipline). If a leader does not meet the minimum promotional requirement, they must attend Night School which begins the week of Monday, February 1, 2016 and ends during the week of April 11, 2016.

Cost: If a leader failed a core class, elective class, advisory, or discipline, the cost is \$140. If a leader did not meet the community service benchmark, the cost is \$35.

Refunds: Once enrolled, leaders cannot receive a refund for any portion of the cost. For every class enrolled, leaders will be charged \$140 per class.
