As you know, we have semester benchmarks for community service. The first semester benchmark is on January 20th. Freshman must complete 5 hours and sophomores must complete 10 hours (20 hours for transfers). If your leader does not meet this benchmark, they will have to go to night school and be charged \$35.

Nigh School

Night School will be held during the weeks of Monday, February 2nd—May4th. If your leader failed **ANY Class** for the first semester, they must attend night school. Letters will be sent home Tuesday, January 20th to notify families if your leader needs to attend Night School. Registration will begin on Friday, January 23rd at 4pm. A minimum of \$35 is required upon registering for any night school class. The cost for each core class and advisory is \$140.
