Quarter 2: Report Card Pick-Up

At Butler College Prep, Report Card Pick-Up (RCPU) is one of our favorite times of the year because we are able to set aside time to discuss your leader's success. Night School Registration

Leaders MUST attend night school for the following reasons to recover first semester credits:

1. Received a "F" in a core class
2. Received a "F" in a elective class
3. Received below a 90% in advisory
4. Has 13 or more detentions
5. Did not meet the community service deadline

Cost: If a leader failed a core class, elective class, advisory, or discipline, the cost is \$140. If a leader did not meet the community service benchmark, the cost is \$35. Minimum deposit of \$35 due by Friday, January 29th.

Refunds: Once enrolled, leaders cannot receive a refund for any portion of the cost. For every class enrolled, leaders will be charged \$140 per class.

Night School Sessions: Begin next week February 1st and end the week of April 25th (3:50pm-5:50pm).
