Last Chance for Enrichment Credits

The third trimester enrichment classes will begin the week of March 16th. The enrichments are as follow:

The cost of each enrichment is \$35. Leaders must pay a minimum cash deposit of \$10 to be enrolled in each class. If promotional requirements are not met, Leaders will have to attend summer school to recover credits. Leaders can only miss two classes and receive no more than eight demerits.
