Semester 2 Good Standing Class

Leaders who “break school rules or fail to serve the penalty for breaking them may lose their good standing status at school. For those who are not in good standing, this could result in not eating lunch with classmates and in not being eligible for some sports, dances, proms, camp, activities and field trips.” **As a result, Leaders who have been suspended will have to attend Good Standing Class on Saturday, May 16 from 8:00am–11:00 am. Leaders who are late will not be able to participate and will have to return home. Leaders must be in full uniform (this includes ID) and must have paper and a writing utensil.
