Are you failing any of your promotional requirements?

Our goal is for all leaders to receive a quality education in a safe environment which will result in leaders graduating high school and attending college. For this reason, we offer several supports for leaders to be the best in all promotional requirement areas (i.e. attendance, health/fitness, academics, enrichment, community service and discipline). If a leader does not meet the minimum promotional requirements, they must attend Night School which begins the week of Monday, February 13, 2017 and ends during the week of May 15, 2017.

Cost: If a leader failed a core class, elective class, advisory, or discipline, the cost is \$100. If a leader did not meet the community service benchmark, the cost is \$35.

Refunds: Once enrolled, leaders cannot receive a refund for any portion of the cost. For every class enrolled, leaders will be charged \$100 per class.
